Driveway Sealer

Hazards

- May contain polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, many of which are carcinogenic and can be absorbed through the skin.

Handling

- Keep driveway sealer in closed containers.
- Wear rubber gloves when handling.
- Most driveway sealers are now latex products (water-based). Keep from freezing.

Management Options

- Try to use up what you have if product is usable, or donate to a neighbor, paving contractor or other who may use it.
- For surplus latex-based sealer, dry out in small amounts and place in the trash.
- Dried driveway sealer, either latex or oil-based, can be thrown in trash with lid off.
- For surplus oil-based, take to hazardous household waste collection, if accepted, or take to a Household Hazardous Products Collection Center.
