!!Flares <u>are not</u> accepted at the Collection Center!! Flares

Hazards

- Extreme caution must be exercised when lighting flares.
- Flares produce a large amount of smoke when lit.

Handling

• Store flares in a dry location. Keep out of reach of children or pets.

Management Options

- Call the local fire department to see if staff there can manage them.
- Some fife departments collect them to donate to fife safety training academics.
- For road flares:
 - o Call the Massachusetts Highway Department district office nearest you to see if they may be able to use them on any upcoming roadwork projects.
- For boat flares:
 - Help arrange a demo day with the Coast Guard for boaters on how to use flares.
 Boating clubs may also be able to arrange demo days.
 - Check with the <u>Coast Guard Auxiliary Flotilla</u> or <u>Power Squadrons</u> to see if they can use them.
 - Do not light them without permission from the Coast Guard as it is a federal offense to call a false emergency.
